This year, PermitTechNation (PTN) and Women in Code Enforcement and Development (WICED) will be celebrating their 9th year of partnering for the PTN/WICED ICC Chapters Day of Service held the Saturday prior to the start of the ICC Annual Convention. This annual event is our chance, as part of the ICC Family, to give back to the communities we visit in a meaningful and productive way.

On Saturday, Oct. 7, we have the opportunity to give back to two worthy causes, Habitat for Humanity (HFHSTL) and the Missouri Veterans Endeavor (MOVESTL).
